To read fluently

- Read out loud familiar words, phrases and short texts.
- Use phonic knowledge to read words.
- Read and understand short written phrases and texts.
- Use translation dictionaries or glossaries to find out the meanings of new words.

To express ideas clearly in writing

- Write familiar words accurately focusing on spelling, diacritics and letter case.
- Write short phrases, using everyday words, correctly.
- Write one or two short sentences, including common questions and responses, accurately.
- Write short phrases from memory with spelling that is understandable.

To interpret the spoken language accurately and speak confidently

- Understand a range of spoken words in the standard language.
- Understand a range of spoken phrases and sentences in the standard language.
- Pronounce words showing a knowledge of sound patterns.
- Ask others to repeat words or phrases.
- Take part in conversations: ask and answer familiar and simple questions.
- Demonstrate a growing vocabulary.

To appreciate aspects of the culture of Spain and some other Spanish-speaking countries

- Identify countries where Spanish is spoken.
- Describe with some interesting detail customs and features of Spain.
- Make comparisons between life in Spain and England.

To read fluently

- Read and understand the main points, opinions and some of the detail in short written texts from various contexts.
- Use the context of a sentence or translation dictionary to work out the meaning of unfamiliar words.
- Read short written texts with accurate pronunciation.
- Show confidence in reading aloud.

To express ideas clearly in writing

- Write short texts on familiar topics, including some phrases from memory.
- Use knowledge of grammar, enhancing or changing the meaning of phrases where appropriate.
- Use dictionaries or glossaries to check words.
- Refer to people, places, things and everyday activities.
- Convey meaning (although there may be some mistakes, the meaning can be understood with little or no difficulty).

To interpret the spoken language accurately and speak confidently

- Understand the main points and opinions in spoken passages.
- Give a short prepared talk that includes opinions and demonstrates a growing vocabulary.
- Take part in conversations to seek and give information.
- Refer to people, places, things and everyday activities.
- Communicate with a range of audiences.
- Be understood with little or no difficulty.

To appreciate aspects of the culture of Spain and some other Spanish-speaking countries

- Give detailed accounts of aspects of the culture, geography and history of Spain.
- Describe, with interesting detail, some similarities and differences between the culture of Spain and our own culture in England.
- Understand aspects of the culture of some other Spanish-speaking countries.
