Year Group	Song	Costume	Notes
Year 3	He's Seen the Light	School uniform	Ideally trousers or skirt with a pocket but not essential. We will supply the additional items required.
Year 4	Christmas is Banned	½ class – school uniform ½ class – trousers, shirt and tie (not school tie)	We will supply the additional items required. Mrs Bird will inform you asap which of the two costumes your child will need.
Year 5	Old Miss Pincher	School uniform	We will supply the additional items required.
Year 6 (including drama club)	Horribly Wrong	Fingerless gloves, ragged trousers and a blanket to drape around the shoulders.	General unkempt look (hair).
Years 3 – 6 Whole Cast	Going Crackers	N/A	
Drama Club only	This Time of Year	School to supply drama club costumes; we will request support with basic items (plain t-shirt, leggings etc. This will be shared with you once roles are allocated.
