



Is your child ready for Nursery?

The following suggestions are to help your child prepare for nursery.

- Be able to separate from parent/carer.
- Be confident to use age-appropriate climbing equipment when at the park.
- Be potty/toilet trained (unless there is a medical condition).
- Be able to put a coat on independently and have a go at putting on shoes.
- Be able to sit and listen to a short story.
- Be able to wipe own nose and attempt to blow it.
- Be able to drink from a cup with no lid, without spilling.
- Use a fork and spoon to eat independently.
- Follow a simple instruction and understand when told not to do something.
- Recognise their own belongings e.g. coat, shoes, bag, water bottle.
- Play alongside other children of a similar age.
